STUDENT ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT



The actions of Elgin Park student-athletes are a reflection of themselves, their team, their school, and their community. A student's involvement in school sports provides opportunities and experiences that are important to the development of a well-rounded student. However, student athletes must remember that their participation in school sport is a privilege, not a right.

Elgin Park Student Athletes shall:

Treat Everyone with Respect

- Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, event organizers and spectators with respect.
- Respect and accept with dignity the decisions of officials
- Be generous in winning and graceful in losing

Exercise Self Control at all Times

- Refrain from the use of drugs or alcohol
- Refrain from the use of foul or profane language
- Refrain from the use of physical force outside the rules of the game

Play Fair

- Play within the rules and the spirit of the rules of the game at all times

Try their best as students

- Attend classes on a regular basis
- Uphold high personal levels of academic achievement by working and learning to the best of their ability

As a member of an Elgin Park team I understand and agree to abide by the set of standards outlined in the Code of Conduct. Upon violation of any of these standards, while as a member of the team or while attending a school function, I understand that I will be disciplined as seen fit by the Athletic Director and Administration. Possible consequences may include:

- Suspension from the team for the remainder of the season
- Suspension from all athletics for the remainder of the seasons
- Suspension from Elgin Park Secondary
